

Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse
by the Gawler & Barossa Racing Club on Sunday, 16
May 2021

RACE 1: TAB TWO-YEARS-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

TANAKA SON (B. Vorster) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

ALASKAN STORM (K. Crowther) - laid in from the 600 metres and in the vicinity of the 150 metres shifted in, resulting in K. Crowther having to stop riding for some distance in an attempt to straighten her mount.

ARTFUL RAIDER (F. Atkinson) - jumped away awkwardly.

BELLAVARDO (NZ) (D. Stra) - raced greenly in the straight.

MADAM FURPHY (K. Zechner) - jumped away awkwardly.

SADLER'S SONG (R. Hurdle) - approaching the 400 metres allowed his mount to shift in and tighten the running of SPANISH MIRACLE. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised that in future to that he must make a greater effort to keep his mount straight. Rider reported that SADLER'S SONG laid in throughout the event.

SPANGLED BRAVERY (D. Tourneur) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SPANISH MIRACLE (C. Jones) - approaching the 400 metres was steadied when tightened by SADLER'S SONG.

RACE 2: AUSBIA ELECTRICAL MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

TURN TABLE (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly. Subsequent to the declaration of correct weight Trainer, Mr J. Stephens, advised Stewards that a barrier blanket was applied to his runner TURN TABLE which was not part of its approved gear. On review of the official vision, Stewards were able to confirm this. Stewards interviewed the Starter, Mr S. Pearson, and it was established that the barrier blanket had been inadvertently added to the gelding. Stewards were of the opinion that the barrier blanket did not impede the gelding and it was able to jump away with the field.



RACE 2: AUSBIA ELECTRICAL MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres (Cont'd)

LADY ADELE (E. Boyd) – Stood flat-footed as the start was effected and, as a result, was slow to begin (three lengths).

CASSANDRA ISABEL (A. Chung) – laid out rounding the home turn.

FRENCH FIELDS (B. Vorster) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 3: KINGSFORD HOTEL MAIDEN PLATE - 1506 Metres

ANGELS CHANT (S. Fawke) – inside the 500 metres rolled out tightening the running of CHARGING FIRE for a short distance. Rider was advised to exercise more care when his mounts begin to weaken and shift ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHARGING FIRE (K. Crowther) – inside the 500 metres was obliged to race in restricted room for a short distance between ANGELS CHANT which shifted out and LUTZ.

LUTZ (C. Jones) – jumped away awkwardly. Raced three wide throughout. Laid out rounding the home turn.

DARJOY (J. Maund) – A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer, Mr. B. Campbell, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness is required prior to any future race or trial.

RACE 4: GJ CIVIL DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE RACE - 2112 Metres

WHOSEZOU (K. Zechner) – acting on confirmed advice from Trainer, Mr. R. Balfour, that the gelding was lame in the near foreleg, Stewards withdrew WHOSEZOU at 10:34 am. Mr Balfour was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness is required prior to any future race or trial.

CARRY THE MUSKET (J. Maund) – laid out from the 400 metres until the 300 metres.

PENONG (NZ) (B. Price) – laid in in the straight. Rider was questioned in relation to the riding of the gelding over the final stages of the event. B. Price pleaded guilty to a charge under AR131(b) in that he failed to ride his mount out to the end of the race for approximately three strides and was fined \$400.

REDENZO BULLET (S. Fawke) – A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SMART PROMISE (J. Holder) – became fractious after being loaded into the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to run.

VICTORY BANDIT (E. Boyd) – rider stated that she could offer no explanation for the filly in that it did not finish the race off as anticipated.


RACE 5: COOPERS BREWERY BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1506 Metres

THE KRONE (B. Vorster) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Inside the 400 metres rolled out.

MARINA (J. Maund) – inside the 400 metres shifted out and away from THE KRONE despite the efforts of its rider taking WINTER HARBOUR wider.

WINTER HARBOUR (D. Tourneur) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Was obliged to be steadied when taken out across the heels of CASHIN' CHEX (NZ) by MARINA which shifted out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: ADELAIDE PLAINS BLOODSTOCK BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1706 Metres



POWER GLEN (M. Aitken) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty, Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by M. Aitken and noted that he used his whip on two occasions over the last 100 metres.



RACE 6: ADELAIDE PLAINS BLOODSTOCK BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1706 Metres (Cont'd)

NEAR MAGIC (J. Maund) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

CITY BEATS (A. Chung) - laid out in the straight.

WOULDA THOUGHT SO (J. Holder) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout the event.

AL MA BELLE (D. Tootell (Snr)) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FORAOISE (B. Price) - made contact with the barrier gate prior to being loaded. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start.

RACE 7: HOLDFAST INSURANCE 0-58 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

TRUMPSTA (C. Jones) - bumped on jumping away by HATEECH which shifted in.

EQUAL BALANCE (M. Aitken) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the 400 metres until approaching the 200 metres. Approaching the 100 metres, when attempting a tight run to the inside of HONEY GO LIGHTLY which had shifted in. Raced in restricted room for some distance then shifted in across the running of FREE OF SIN. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised in future to only attempt runs when there is sufficient room to do so.

OLIVE GROVE (K. Zechner) - bumped on jumping away. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Approaching the 800 metres was obliged to be steadied away from the heels of VINDEX which had rolled in.

HATEECH (B. Price) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped TRUMPSTA. Approaching the 100 metres was obliged to be steadied when racing in restricted room for a short distance to the inside of FREE OF SIN which was taken in.

FREE OF SIN (J. Toeroek) - laid in throughout the event. Rolled about in the straight. Approaching the 100 metres was obliged to be steadied to avoid the heels of EQUAL BALANCE which shifted in.

HONEY GO LIGHTLY (T. Pannell) - laid in in the straight. Approaching the 100 metres shifted in tightening the running of EQUAL BALANCE. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised in future to straighten his mount sooner when they commence to shift ground.

VINDEX (A. Chung) - jumped away awkwardly. Shifted in and bumped OLIVE GROVE. Approaching the 800 metres rolled in and inconvenienced OLIVE GROVE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a laceration to the near hind cannon.

SHOWUSYOURMOTOR (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out in the straight.

RACE 8: TERRACE FUNCTION CENTRE BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

GO BALLISTIC (D. Tourneur) - in the vicinity of the 100 metres was obliged to be steadied momentarily to avoid the heels of HE WILL BOOM which laid out.

HE WILL BOOM (K. Crowther) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid out in the straight.

TURF TAPPER (M. Aitken) - shortened stride for no apparent reason approaching the finish. Rider explained that inside the final 50 metres TURF TAPPER got its head up and shortened stride and shortly after became awkward in its action and, for this reason, he was reluctant to fully test the gelding to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr S. Cahill, was advised to report any abnormalities that may arise with TURF TAPPER in the coming days. Mr. Cahill was also advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness is required prior to any future race or trial. Subsequently, Mr Cahill advised Stewards the gelding did not eat up after returning to the stable and he has made an appointment for a veterinary examination after which he will forward the results to the Stewards.

ZOUSTORM (D. Tootell (Snr)) - jumped away awkwardly and, as a result, was slow to begin.

RACE 8: TERRACE FUNCTION CENTRE BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres (Cont'd)

CARTIER TIARA (C. Lions) - held up for clear running from the 500 metres until the inside the 400 metres where she was obliged to alter course to the outside of LICORICE BULLET to obtain clear running.

LICORICE BULLET (F. Atkinson) - laid in in the straight.
