Report on Race Meeting held at Hawker Racecourse
by the Hawker Racing Club on Saturday, 29 May
2021

RACE 1: SMULDERS CONTRACTING MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 Metres

ILLUSION DATE (NZ) (A. Livesey) - inside the 100 metres shifted in onto REDENZO BULLET, which was taken in and momentarily inconvenienced SUGAR WITH THAT.

OSIRIS (A. Chung) - began awkwardly, shifted out and hampered SUGAR WITH THAT.

REDENZO BULLET (D. Tootell (Snr)) - inside the 100 metres was taken in by ILLUSION DATE (NZ) onto SUGAR WITH THAT, which was momentarily inconvenienced.

SUGAR WITH THAT (M. Henderson) - hampered on jumping away by OSIRIS, which shifted out. Inside the 100 metres was momentarily inconvenienced by REDENZO BULLET, which was taken in by ILLUSION DATE (NZ).

RACE 2: HILDERCO MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

ZIPADEE (A. Livesey) - rider reported that the mare hung out rounding the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

POCKET PENNY (E. Wong) - shifted wider on the track rounding the home turn.

RACE 3: HAWKER EARTHMOVERS BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

JACKPOT JOHNNY (A. Livesey) - slow to begin losing several lengths and thereafter was slow into stride.

VIETTI (F. Atkinson) - jumped away awkwardly. Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 3: HAWKER EARTHMOVERS BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres (cont'd)

GOLDEN PHYSICIAN (M. Vassallo) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by M. Vassallo and noted that he used it on nine occasions over the final 100 metres of the event.

LADY CORNELIA (E. Annells) – rider reported that the mare laid in throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NEWBAY FLYER (NZ) – late scratching at 9.20 am by order of the Stewards as there was no rider available.

RACE 4: NORTHPOINT TOYOTA HAWKER CUP - 1750 Metres

CHARLTON (E. Annells) – rider explained that her intention was to settle midfield in today's event; however, owing to her wide barrier and the formation of the field in the early stages she was unable to take up a midfield position early and was obliged race wide without cover for some distance before settling back with cover.

SIZZLING BULLET (F. Atkinson) – jumped away awkwardly. Laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DUKE OF CHRISTOPHE – late scratching at 8.08 am by order of the Stewards as there was no rider available.

RACE 5: ELDERS RATING 0-54 HANDICAP - 1750 Metres

ORLEANS (F. Atkinson) – rider explained that when challenged for the lead by CITY BEATS near the 800 metres her horse got off the bridle and thereafter did not finish the race off as expected. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ICE HUNT (E. Annells) – jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.
