Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse

Wednesday, 18 August 2021

TRACK: Soft 6 (Moist but not a badly affected track)

RAIL: Out 8 metres 800 metres to 350 metres, out 7 metres 1700 metres to 1500 metres, out 6 metres remainder.

RACE 1: TAB BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1732 Metres

MASARU WARRIOR (J. Holder) - rider reported that the gelding changed strides on a number of occasions over the concluding 100 metres and he became concerned with its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

YOUNG LARS (B. Vorster) - slow to begin. Rider reported that the gelding hung out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BELLS 'N' BOWS (J. Potter) - slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

DELUXE DESIGN (G. Lo) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.


DOMESDAY MAGIC (J. Maund) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 2: XMAS PARTY AT THE RACES - SAT 18 DEC MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

HARD RANSOM (P. Gatt) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

AXESTOCK GIRL (NZ) (E. Wong) - slow to begin. Rider reported that he was concerned with the mare's action throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off foreleg. Co-trainers, Mr J. Dunn and Ms K. Bishop, were advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

LEANNABELLE (J. Toeroek) - rider reported that the mare never travelled during the event and when placed under pressure failed to respond to his riding and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 2: XMAS PARTY AT THE RACES – SAT 18 DEC MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres (cont'd)

SHE'S ESTELLE (J. Holder) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by J. Holder and noted that he used it on seven occasions over the concluding 100 metres of the event.

STARSONGARI (B. Vorster) - fractious in the barrier after being loaded. Trainer, Mr C. Bieg, was advised that a warning had been placed on the filly in relation to its barrier manners. Slow to begin.

I'M A SHOW (C. Lions) - reared on a number of occasions and refused to proceed to the start. Stewards declared I'M A SHOW a late scratching at 12.05 pm. Trainer, Mr T. Day, was advised that the mare was now required to proceed to the start without delay in an Official Barrier Trial prior to a future race start.

RACE 3: GAWLER CARNIVAL OF CUPS – OCT 15-24 MAIDEN PLATE - 1522 Metres

SEMYORKA (D. Caboche) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TRANSFERENCE (T. Pannell) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

RUPPAPUMPUM (NZ) (M. Vassallo) - slow to begin.

VONDEXTER (G. Lo) - rider reported that he had become concerned with the mare's action from the 600 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: GBJC LIFE MEMBERS CUP BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 2132 Metres

PLAISIR (J. Maund) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by J. Maund and noted that he used it on eight occasions over the concluding 100 metres of the event.

GALAXY FALLS (J. Potter) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed an atypical arrhythmia. Trainer, Mr K. Healy, was advised that the results of an ECG were to be forwarded to the Racing SA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness were required prior to the gelding performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.

AUSSIE SOJOURN (S. Metcalfe) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

TIZA (E. Annells) - slow to begin. Raced fiercely in the middle stages of the event. Rider explained that she had been instructed to find a position with cover in the early stages; however, after doing so her saddle shifted forward slightly and the mare commenced to over-race and improved outside the field to sit outside the leader despite her efforts. She added that when asked for an effort near the 600 metres TIZA had failed to respond to her riding and weakened from the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SEMINOLES (NZ) (D. Tourneur) - trainer, Ms K. Byrnes, advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that she would instruct her rider to attempt to obtain a position midfield if possible. Settled midfield.

SOSTENIDO (NZ) (S. Logan) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by S. Logan and noted that she used it on four occasions over the concluding 100 metres of the event.



RACE 5: GC&J CONSTRUCTIONS BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1522 Metres

Prior to this event a strapper was injured in the mounting yard requiring assistance from the First Care Medical personnel. As a result all races were put back one race time. Race 9 was rescheduled to start at 4.40 pm.



RACE 5: GC&J CONSTRUCTIONS BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1522 Metres (cont'd)

CALL ME DEXTER (E. Wong) - laid in under pressure in the straight, and in the vicinity of the 200 metres had to be steadied to avoid the heels of DON'T DISMISS, which shifted out at the same time as CALL ME DEXTER shifted in. Continued to lay in under pressure over the concluding 200 metres taking DON'T DISMISS in. E. Wong was reminded of his obligations and advised in future to make a greater effort to keep his mounts straight when they commence to shift ground.

DON'T DISMISS (B. Price) - in the vicinity of the 300 metres improved onto the heels of FIGHT FOR FREEDOM, which had commenced to give ground, and shifted out to improve. In doing so DON'T DISMISS shifted into the running line of CALL ME DEXTER, which was forced to be steadied. Rider was severely reprimanded and advised in future to ensure he was sufficiently clear prior to shifting ground.

MR EPIC (R. Hurdle) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

THE BOY WONDER (NZ) (D. Caboche) - slow to begin.

CARBONE (J. Potter) - slow to begin.

HARBOURING (C. Jones) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: GAWLER CLUB MEMBERSHIPS - DUE NOW! BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1522 Metres

AL BADR (J. Maund) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GETOUTTHEWAY (C. Jones) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until near the 300 metres when it was able to alter course to obtain clear ground.

CALL ME HERBIE (E. Annells) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event, and inside the 1100 metres E. Annells was forced to take hold to avoid the heels of BEAU'S MY BOY, which shifted in.

BEAU'S MY BOY (S. Logan) - inside the 1100 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of CALL ME HERBIE, forcing the rider to take hold to avoid the heels of the gelding. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR131(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight Wednesday, 25 August 2021 and to conclude at midnight Wednesday, 1 September 2021, a period of three meetings.

MAGUS MAN (J. Opperman) - inconvenienced near the 400 metres when forced to race in restricted room for a number of strides when awkwardly placed between the heels of MUFFLA and DETENTORE (NZ).

RACE 7: SANDERS FODDER BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

FENCELINE (P. Gatt) - contacted on jumping away. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WANDERING EYE (K. Zechner) - shifted in on jumping away contacting FENCELINE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EFFORTKAT (D. Tourneur) - inclined to lay out from near the 900 metres until the entrance to the straight. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until the vicinity of the 300 metres.

MARY'S PRIDE (C. Lions) - slow to begin.

CARTIER TIARA (B. Vorster) - laid out under pressure in the straight.





RACE 8: TERRACE FUNCTION CENTRE BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

SIR JOHNSON (E. Wong) - jumped away awkwardly.

RITORNO (K. Zechner) - lost its off fore plate during the event.

RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE (S. Metcalfe) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZIP AKEED (J. Potter) - rider reported that the mare became awkward in its action behind for a stride in the vicinity of the 500 metres.

RACE 9: COOPERS BREWERY CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

MR WHITACRE (K. Zechner) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event when awkwardly placed on the heels of GO BUNDLE, which shifted in.

HI SMOKEY (J. Potter) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

GO BUNDLE (M. Aitken) - shifted in, in the vicinity of the 1000 metres onto MR WHITACRE. Rider was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

CHARMED INDIVIDUAL (NZ) (D. Caboche) - rider reported that the gelding became awkward in its action for a stride in the vicinity of the 600 metres for no apparent reason.

BON PEGASUS (E. Annells) - shifted out abruptly for no apparent reason in the vicinity of the 700 metres.

ENLIST (J. Eaton) - slow to begin.

KIROSHIMA (C. Lions) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TINNY BAR BLUE (E. Wong) - was obliged to alter course in the vicinity of the 100 metres when it became awkwardly placed on the heels of HI SMOKEY, which laid out.
